The CANS credential was established to formally recognize nurses who demonstrate advanced expertise in aesthetic and cosmetic nursing. Candidates must meet strict eligibility requirements, including:

- At least two years of specialty experience in plastic/aesthetic surgery, dermatology, ophthalmology or facial plastic surgery.
- A minimum of 1,000 practice hours in these specialties within the past two years.
- Direct collaboration with or supervision by a board-certified core physician.

With only 529 active Certified Aesthetic Nurse Specialists worldwide, this credential is one of the most selective and respected in the field.
